

Panlab implementation (Who implements?)

- What does it mean?
 - Efficient service
 - Global service for regional development
 - Common platform for project results testing
 - Interoperability and conformance testing
 - Minimising risk
 - Reducing the time-to-market (important)
 - Customised test offering
 - Having suitable (catalogue) content available
 - Recommendations for testing and test cases (user groups)
 - Statements about validity of the tested system (app. or serv.)
- Customer = Projects, companies, ...
 - Clear value proposition for the customer
 - Customers as contributing stakeholders

Panlab implementation

- Business models
 - Commercial or non-profit?
 - Varied business models
- Means for finding testing facilities
 - Finding suitable services
 - Finding the correct combinations
 - user profiles
- Interoperability
 - Interoperability testing
 - Labelling for conformance (regional labelling?)
 - Who labels the testbed for quality?

Panlab implementation

- Trust
 - Separating the testers
 - Securing the test systems and systems underneath
 - How to open specifications and allow access
 - Doing testing in parallel or separately
 - Dedicating facilities for a single tester
 - Two-way anonymity (users and testers)
- Interconnecting different facilities
- Is it a black box service or collaborative effort
- Database for all the learnings
 - For academic research

Panlab implementation

- IPR and creating trust
 - Confidentiality of test data
 - Agreement processes
 - Securing all results and capturing further IPR
 - Differentiating between test environment (open) and the system under test (confidential)
- Organising the testing
 - All governance and administration issues
 - Marketing, development, etc.
 - The above could also be separate support services
- How about the interconnection of facilities outside the network and outside of Europe
 - Providing connections through the points that are connected
 - How to reach regional user groups for testing in single location (seems to be challenging)

Panlab implementation

- Might be challenging to make it profitable
 - Perhaps need public money also?
 - Maybe a joint venture between the stakeholders?
