Pan-European Laboratory: On Motivation

- For providers
 - Opportunities to increase customer based with broader and enriched testing services
- For customers
 - Avoid multiple [bilateral] contracts with a single contract for multiple services

Pan-European Laboratory: Implementation Means...-1

- Possibility to issue RFT – Request (Call) for Testing
 - Might be general or very specific (detailed)
 - PEL Office would be a single contact point for answering the RFT
- Additional purposes – demo and promotion of new services
- Clear business models for all participants
- Confidentiality + trust
- Clear way to handle competition (vendors, carrier, ...)
- Provide complete picture on available resources
 - Catalog with clear “semantics”, templates
 - Existing and required/possible *ad-hoc* testing services
- Two levels – services/applications and technologies
 - Top-down approach: translate target service testing into required technical infrastructure
- PEL Office is a must
 - Legal entity, or
 - Virtual

Pan-European Laboratory: Implementation Means...-2

- Availability of broad technical guidance
 - Standards, interfaces, specs, etc.
- Providing full assistance with testing environment
 - Required facilities, test plans
 - Competitive pricing
- Enable virtualization of testing resources
- Provide security (Juha's SET)
- Availability of tools to define contractually partners' contributions and benefits
 - Business and legal aspects
- Clear handling of IPR issues
- Database on available testing services & facilities
- Assistance with troubleshooting
